- 3800 providers have been credentialed.
- 700 out patient provider groups
- 300 facilities have been contracted with
- Looking to expand PRTF for both adults and adolescents.
- Looking for specialty programs both in-state and surrounding states
- 6 out of 7 regions now have ACT Teams R6 is Mental Health Specialists it is a half team (up to 50 members)
- 3 ESMI teams in the state 1 in 3&4, 1 in 6 (Best LLC) & 1 in 7 (RHS)
- Stace asked about Act teams in rural counties required to cover full region
- Bill asked about utilization of rural counties for specialty programs

David said a lot of DHW staff moved to COE and have continued services during transition for WA services when needed Matt Hardin is reporting on Mobile Response Teams Now available 8am – 11pm 7 days a week In January – 8 call in R6 – 1 weekend, 2 later evening Rec'd call and response in Lava – all other responses have been in Pocatello Waitlist at providers (specifically for testing) No CDA is required, hours allowed have been expanded Looking to expand the network to decrease wait times Right now some agencies may be 8-10 weeks waits If no insurance or Medicaid – contact Magellan (may be eligible for other state funding through Magellan) Without a medicaid denial members would only be approved for 30 days or funding – once denied can be eligible for a year of funding for services Tonya is asking how to get WA information back out to the schools once services are in place David will work to get information on Magellan's website Suggested DHW COE could also help spread the word
